- 30 minutes Current Status and Success Stories (of CE in Local setting), led by Local Leader/Narrator and others he/she chooses to participate, eg, about CE societies, education, opportunities to connect; ending with Local videos of CEs and their success stories
- 5 minutes Closing of program by Local Leader, with **60-second 'Olympic-like' Global CE Day closing video**, with music, pix and video snippets from submitted.
